

How to Convert AutoCAD Drawings into PDF files using DWG TruView 2011 by Autodesk

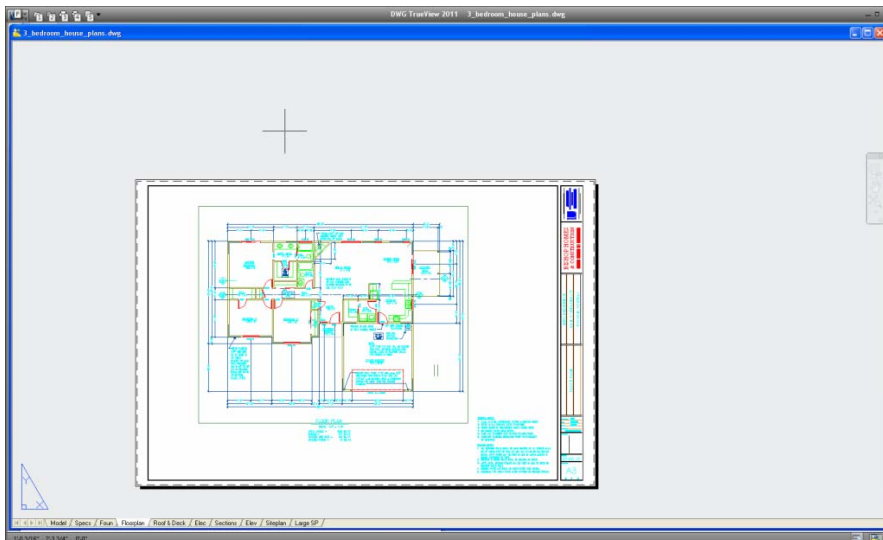
The program is free and can be downloaded from Autodesk .

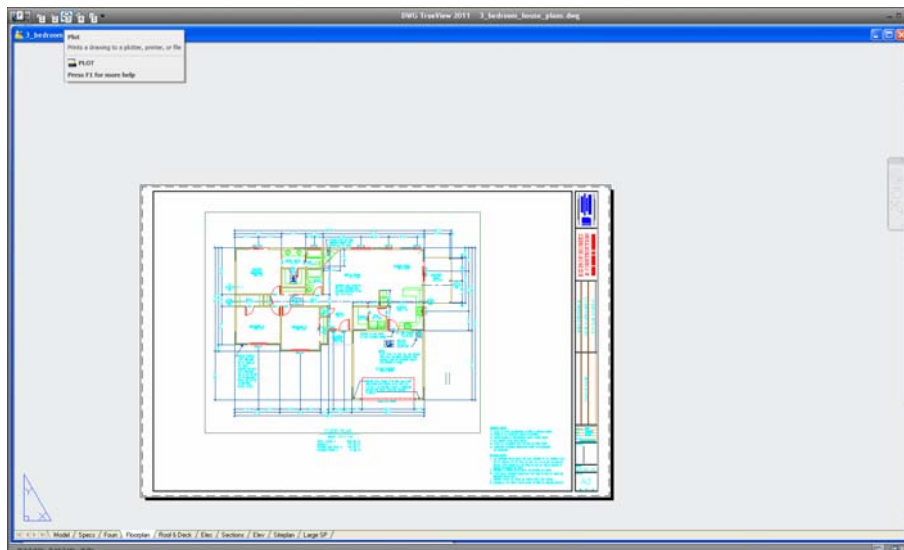

Here is a guide how to create a pdf file in TruView .

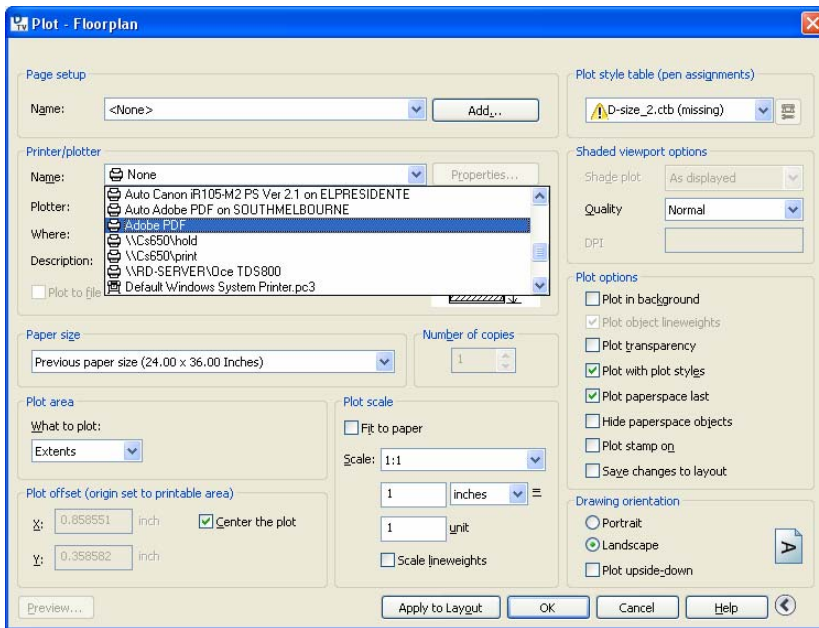
- Open the file , just double click



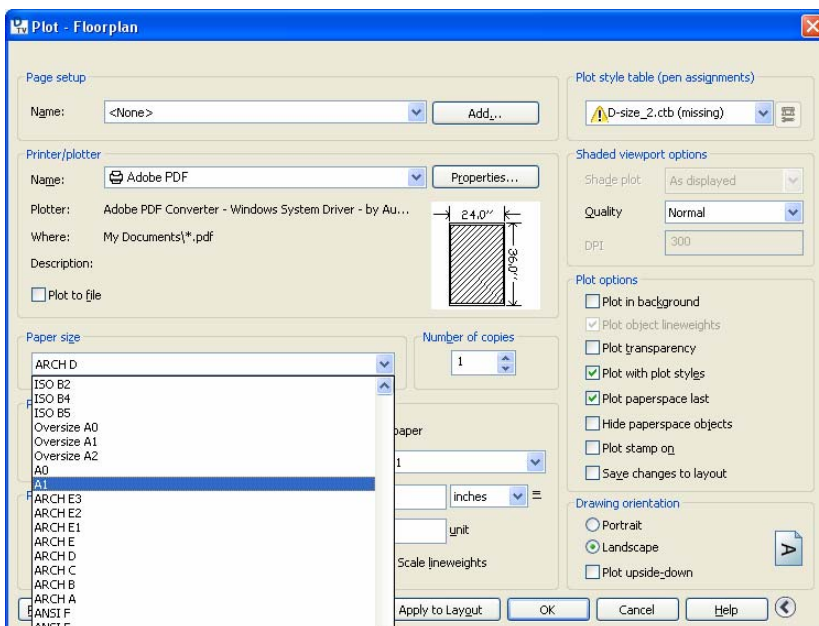
- Select Plot



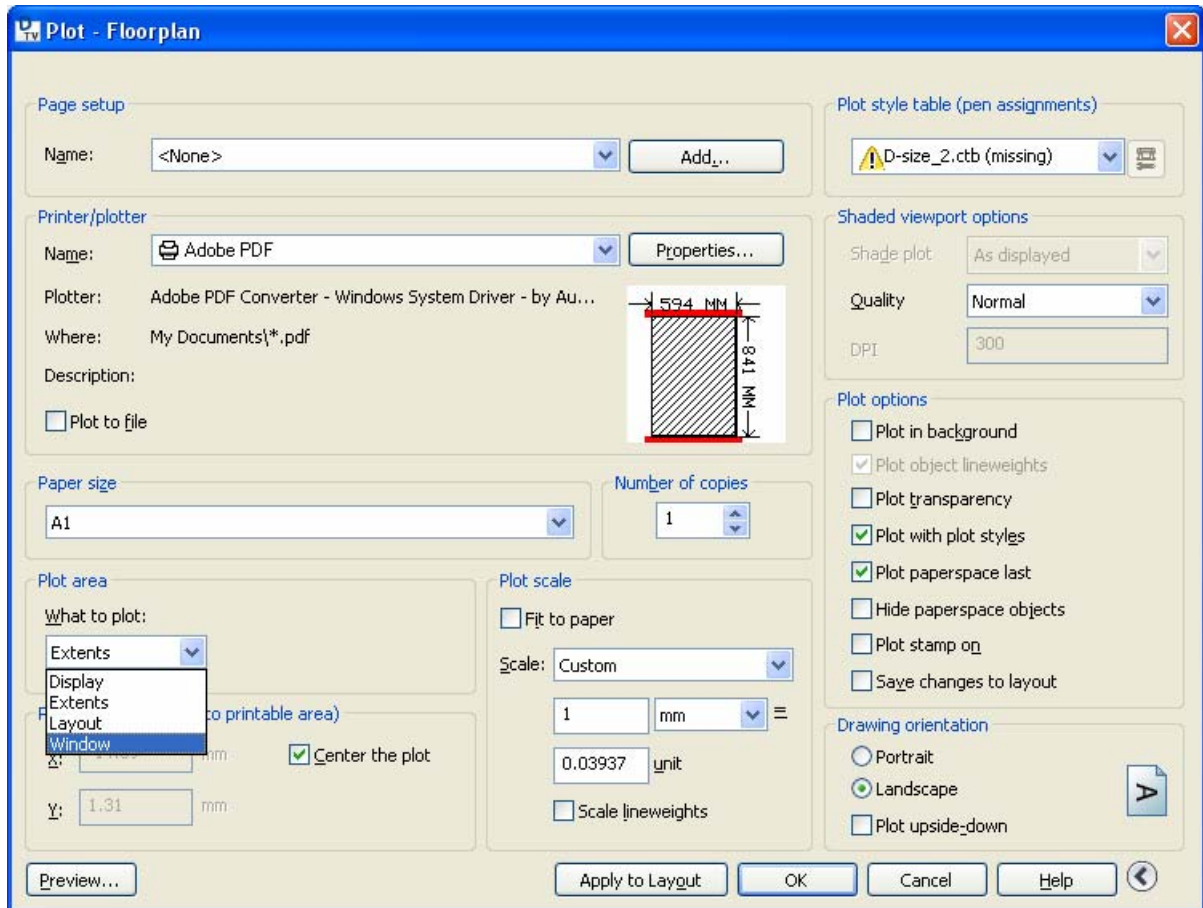
Select driver either plotter or adobe (to create a pdf file)



Select paper size desired



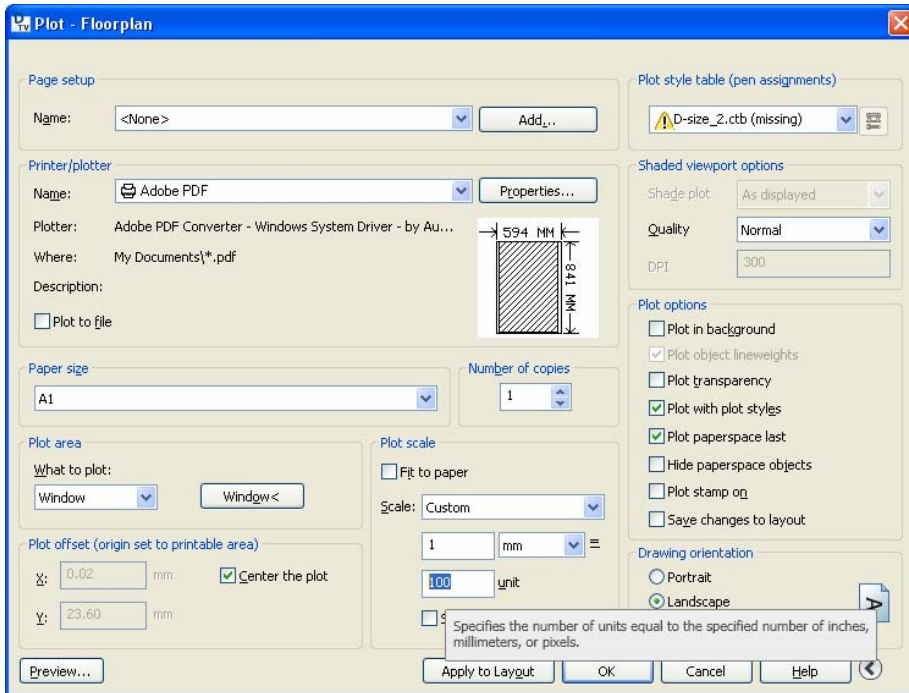
Select area to plot



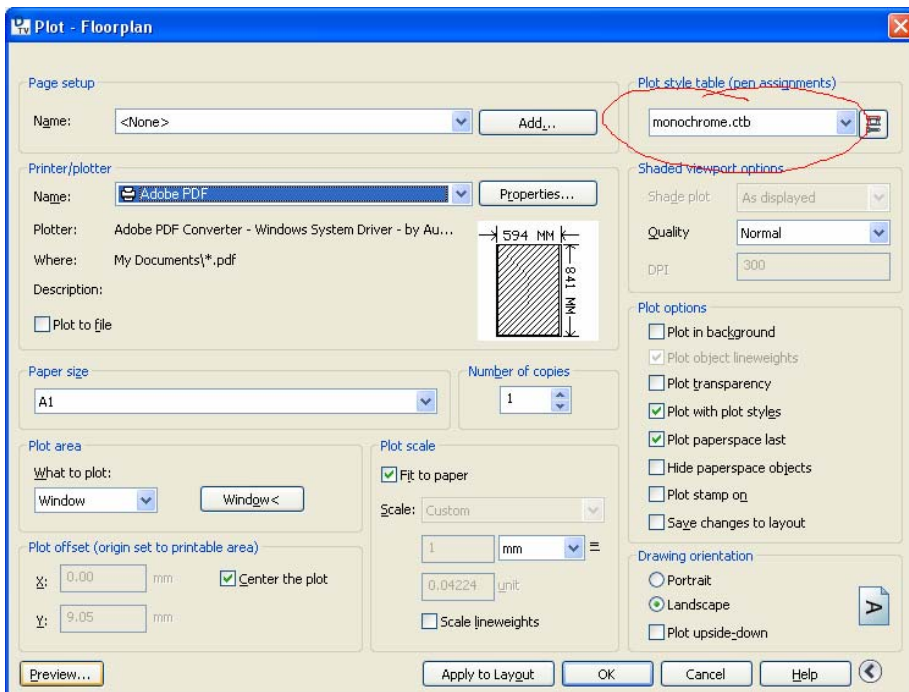
By selecting window you must pick 2 diagonal points of the drawing



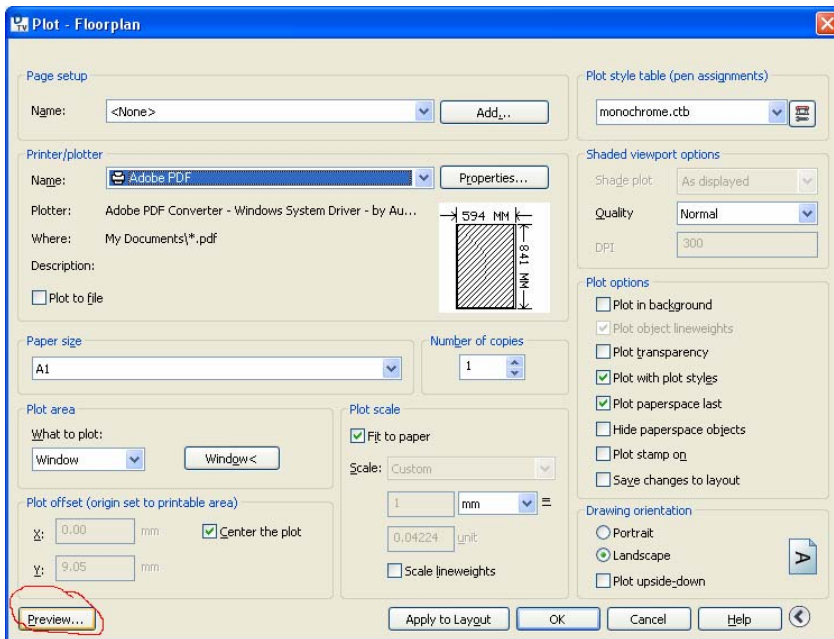
Select scale



Select pen assignments if none available choose monochrome or grayscale

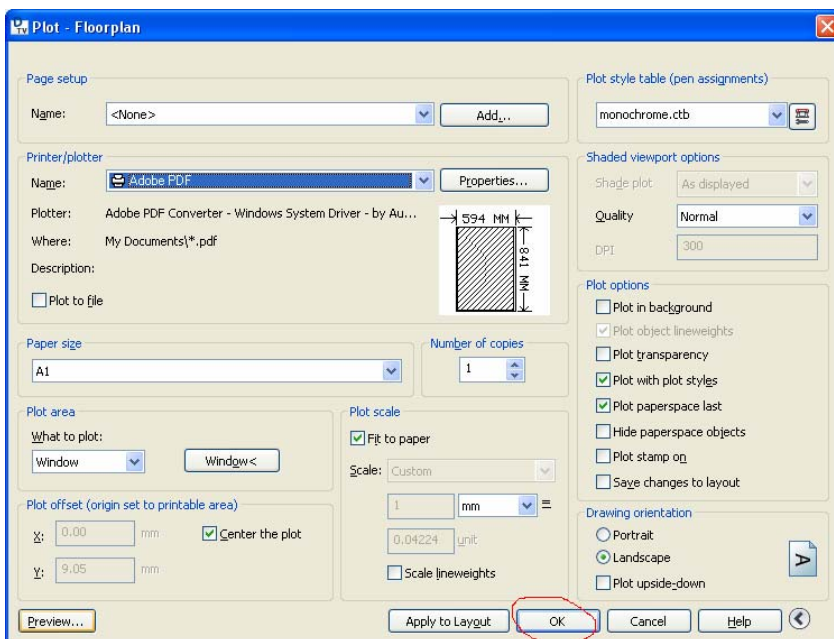


Select print preview, to view what is going to be printed



-Press escape from preview window

-Click on ok if ready to plot



-the pdf should be in the same location as the drawing file.
